

- Apple has 9,000,000 registered developers, up 47% from last year
- 70% of the developers at WWDC this year were first-timers
- Youngest developer at WWDC was 13-years old
- 1,000 Apple engineers at WWDC, 190 sessions, 600 hours of one-on-one training, hands-on, workshops and demos






#### Verify and Test Your On-Site Backups

- \* There are only two kinds of hard disk drives: those that *have* failed, and those that *will* fail.
- \* Restore an old file and an old folder from your Time Machine backup
- \* Boot your machine from your standby full-disk clone HD; check that it is a fresh clone and all files are there
- \* Make sure your cloning routine & cloning software is up-to-date and running on your defined schedule



#### Verify and Test Your Off-Site Backups

- \* Verify your off-site backup service connection & subscription
- \* Restore a folder from your off-site backup
- \* Re-read the emergency restore options & procedures for your service
- \* Update your notes & procedures for your off-site backup system

#### Verify Your Triply-Redudant Backup System


- \* Time Machine: continuous, automatic snapshots of your Mac's HD 24/7; fire-and-forget; perfect for the "Whoops!" deletions all the way through full disk recovery
- \* **Bootable clone**: for the day when your Mac's inboard HD honks the bobo; set Carbon Copy Cloner to run a clone every day to an external USB HD
- \* Off-site unlimited cloud backup: BackBlaze, Carbonite, Mozy, CrashPlan for the day when your house burns down/blows away/floods/blows up/is robbed/floods/is hit by lightning/drops into a sinkhole/has a tree fall on it/a car drives into it/etc., etc.

## Take It One Step at a Time

- Easiest: Time Machine
- Next-Easiest: Bootable Clone on an External HD
- Almost as easy but super-important: Off-site remote backup

## Do It Tonight!

• Buy *two* 1Tb or 2Tb external HDs



#### Time Machine Setup

- Plug HD #1 into your USB port
- Time Machine pops up, offering to use external HD as your Time Machine backup
- Accept all defaults
- Done

#### Bootable Clone Setup

- Plug HD #2 into your USB port
- Download and install Carbon Copy Cloner from bombich.com
- Buy the full license for \$39.95 worth it the first time you need it!
- Follow the "Getting Started" guide in Help in CCC
- ...or have a beer ready and call Mike for a 10-minute hand-holding session


