#### Magic Mirror App





One of my favorite programs is called "Magic Mirror". Like some earlier image distortion apps, it allows the user to create funny-looking still images, but also allows creation of short video clips with both cleverly distorted images including altered sound.



When combining the funny face with the changed sound pitch, some really outrageously hilarious stuff can happen.

Try your hand at creating something silly, and see how much fun you can have.




Funny Movie Maker

Another app that provides me with hours of creative fun is... "Funny Movie Maker".

You can add your lips and voice (with distortions in pitch) to anything from silly pic's available in the app to photos in your own library or celebrity shots you've found on the internet.



Often I will combine silly photos I've created with "Magic Mirror" so I can add the lips and sound using "Funny Movie Maker" to make something extra special, for events like holidays or birthdays.



And putting a human voice and lips on animal pictures can be especially hilarious.



And you can combine your "silly" skills with some simple title slides created on your iPad or iPhone to make some fun projects for entertaining guests.

Just connect your "Keynote" presentation to your HDTV using Apple TV with Airplay and screen mirroring, or connect directly to the TV using and adapter with an HDMI cable.


### READ MY LIPS!
