




AAPL 1Q16 Results

- Record revenue vs. "the mother of all compares" last year's monster iPhone 6 / 6 Plus intro quarter; \$75.9 billion vs. \$74.6 billion, up 1.75% YOY
- Record **profit** vs. "the mother of all compares" last year's monster iPhone 6 / 6 Plus intro quarter; \$18.4 billion vs. \$18 billion, up 2.22%
- Gross margin **rose** to 40.1% from 39.9%
- 66% of sales came from outside the US

"Headwinds"

- Unprecedented currency exchange pressures depressed both revenue and profits by 15% vs. year-ago period
- Cook pointed out that this amounted to a decrease of \$5 billion in additional quarterly sales, which is as much as the average Fortune 500 company does in a year
- The forex hit on Apples' 1Q15 is greater than Facebook's annual revenue
- Dollar strength meant that \$100 of sales in 1Q15 is only \$85 in sales for 1Q16

Currency & China

- Brazilian Real is down more than 40%
- Russian Ruble is down more than 50%
- Euro and British Pound are down double digits
- Canadian dollar, Australian dollar are down 20% or more
- China weakness weighing on all markets, but Apple grew China revenue by 14% YOY; now their largest single country market outside of the US, and growing 30% YOY

Apple's Business Has Never Been Stronger


- 74,779,000 iPhones sold in the quarter
 - Delivered 34,000 iPhones *per hour*, 24/7, for 90 days and ran out
 - That's 9.4 iPhones built, shipped, delivered and activated per second, up 50% vs. year-ago quarter
- Largest-ever quarterly Mac unit volume, still out-performing the industry by 8x
- App Store & services revenues hit \$9 billion, up 20% YOY

"The Mother of All Balance Sheets"

- \$215 billion in cash and no debt; that's \$39 in cash standing behind every share of common stock; almost 80% of Apple's cash is offshore
- Paid out \$37 billion in dividends, bought back \$30 billion of shares on the open market; shareholder capital return total now at \$153 billion, going to \$200 billion this year, possibly higher — largest in the history of business

Currency Index

\$100 of Apple's non-U.S. dollar revenue in Q4'14 translates into only \$85 U.S. dollars today



The currency index is based on the average exchange rate per quarter weighted by Apple's non-U.S. dollar revenue for each quarter.

Q1'16 Constant Currency Revenue Growth

In constant currency, Q1'16 revenue would have been \$5 billion higher, reflecting an 8% Y/Y increase

Apple's installed base drove over \$31 billion in related purchases in FY15, up 23% Y/Y, and almost \$9 billion in Q1'16, up 24% Y/Y

Apple Recovery Boot


Re-Install El Capitan from bootable micro SD card



Restore from a Time Machine backup

Restore specific files:

1. Choose Enter Time Machine from the Time Machine menu €0, or click Time Machine in the Dock.



2. Find the files to restore:

- Use the timeline on the edge of the screen to see the files in your Time Machine backup as they were at that date and time. The timeline may also include local snapshots.
- Use the onscreen up and down arrows to jump to the last time the contents of the window changed. You can also use the search field in a window to find a file, then move through time while focused on changes to that file.
- Select a file and press Space Bar to preview the file and make sure it's the one you want.
- 3. Click Restore to restore the selected file, or Control-click the file for other options.

Restore everything:

- To restore everything in your Time Machine backup, use OS X Recovery.
- To copy the files, settings, and OS X user accounts in your backup to another Mac, use Migration Assistant.



Bootable Backup Clone

- A second external HD connected to your Mac
- Run SuperDuper or Carbon Copy Cloner automatically every day
- Creates a bootable whole-disk bit-for-bit clone of your Mac's internal HD
- This is your reserve parachute for when your internal HD honks the bobo



Unlimited Off-Site Backup


- BackBlaze, Carbonite, Mozy, Amazon Cloud Drive, etc.
- Continuous, automatic, unlimited backups of all user data on your Mac
- This is your "Abandon Ship!" lifeboat



- ...create your own original digital file from the DVD using free software on your Mac!

- A free app called Handbrake
 - Download ONLY from handbrake.fr
- iTunes on your Mac
- Your iPad, iPhone & sync cable

Handbrake Caveats

- Fastest operation on desktop machines (faster CPU, GPU & more RAM)
- Works best on non-Hollywood studio DVDs
- Many DVDs cannot be ripped (yet) stronger encryption by MPAA & Hollywood, but the developers are working on it
- It's free! Give it a try!




