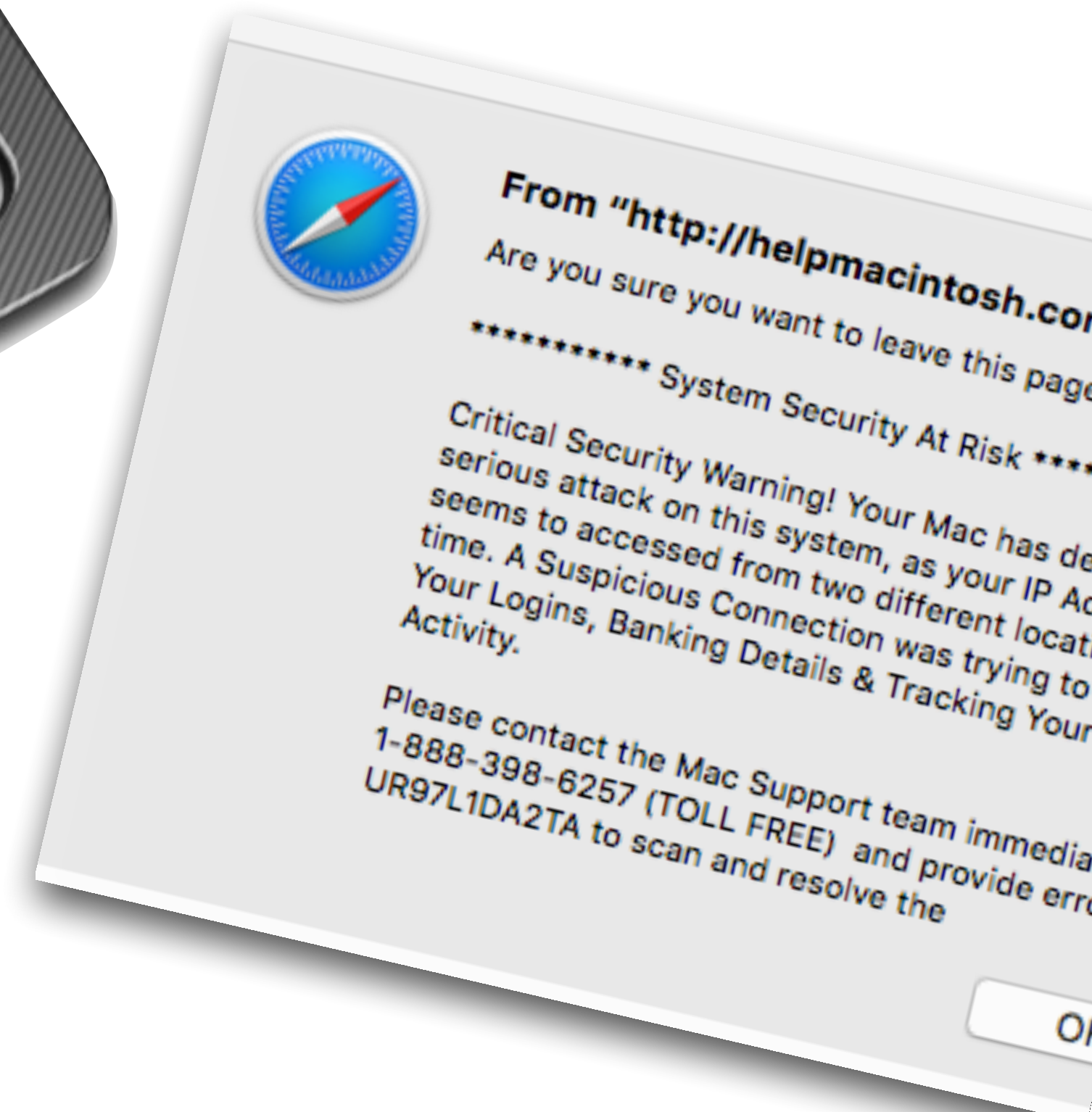

- Transmission is an open-source P2P “BitTorrent” file sharing app
- 2.90 version is affected; now cleaned; Apple investigating
- How many of you ever heard of Transmission before this minute or this week?

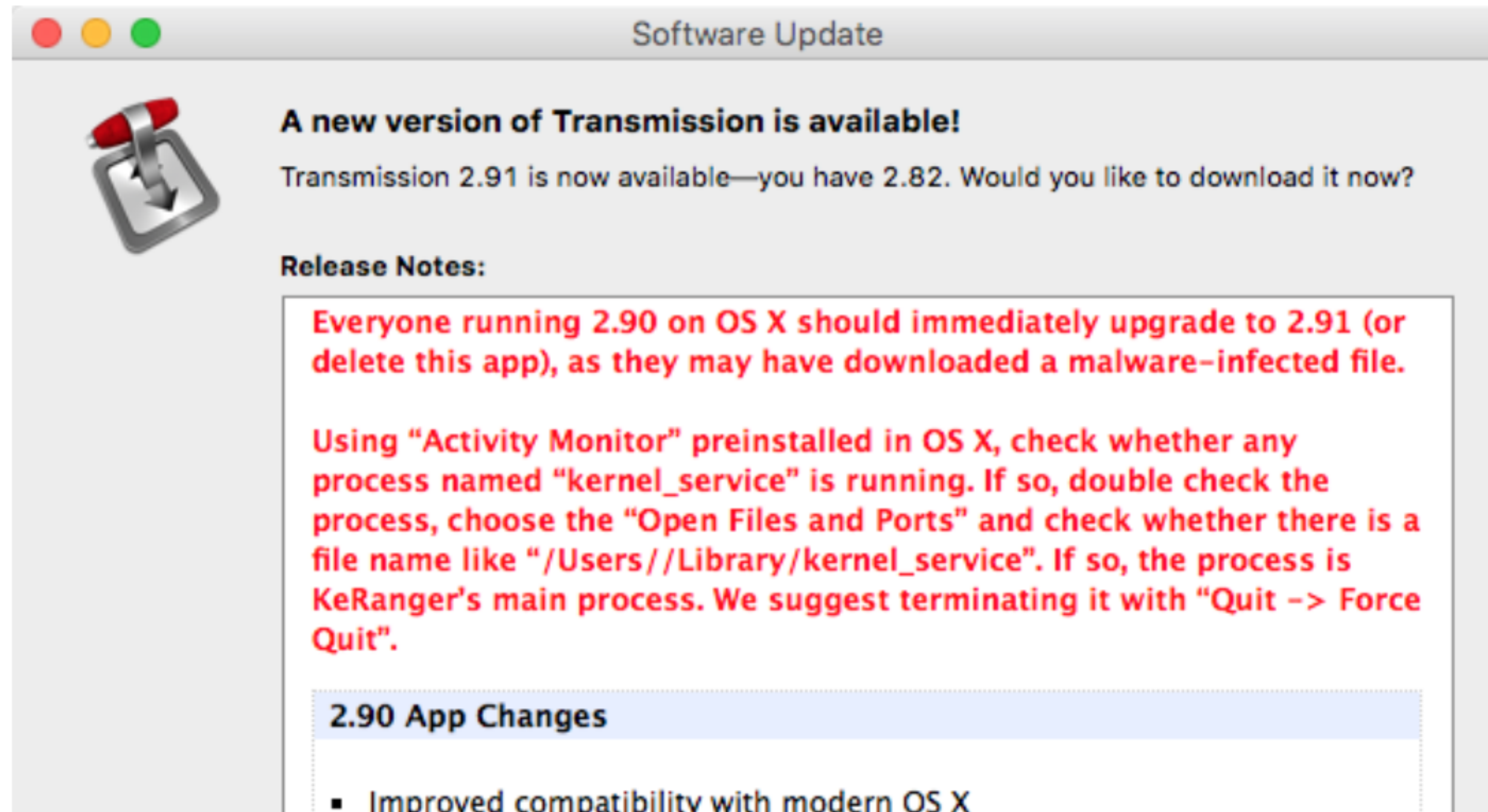


Transmission Malware Transmitted Through Server Hack, Downloaded 6,500 Times

Over the weekend, the [first instance of Mac ransomware](#) was found in a malicious update to the *Transmission* BitTorrent client. Version 2.90 of *Transmission* downloaded from the Transmission website was infected with "KeRanger" ransomware.

"Ransomware" is a class of malware that encrypts a user's hard drive and files, demanding money to decrypt it. In this case, KeRanger would have required Mac users to shell out a bitcoin for decryption, equivalent to approximately \$400.




The First OS X Malware in The Wild

- User's machines infected with "KeRanger" ransomware
- 3-day incubation period
- Phones home to C&C servers
- Encrypts some user files in the Home folder
- Presents users with \$400 ransom demand



Best Practices



- Keep your Mac up-to-date
 -  → App Store → Updates
- Use Mike's 3-legged data backup program
 - Time Machine
 - Bit-for-Bit Bootable Clone
 - Offsite Whole-Disk Backup

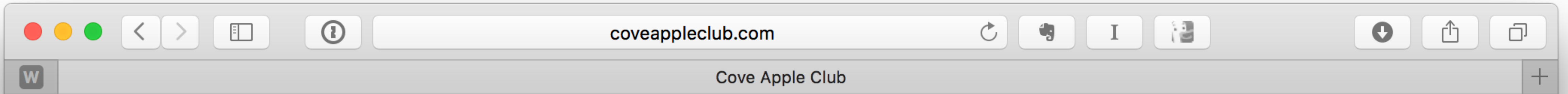

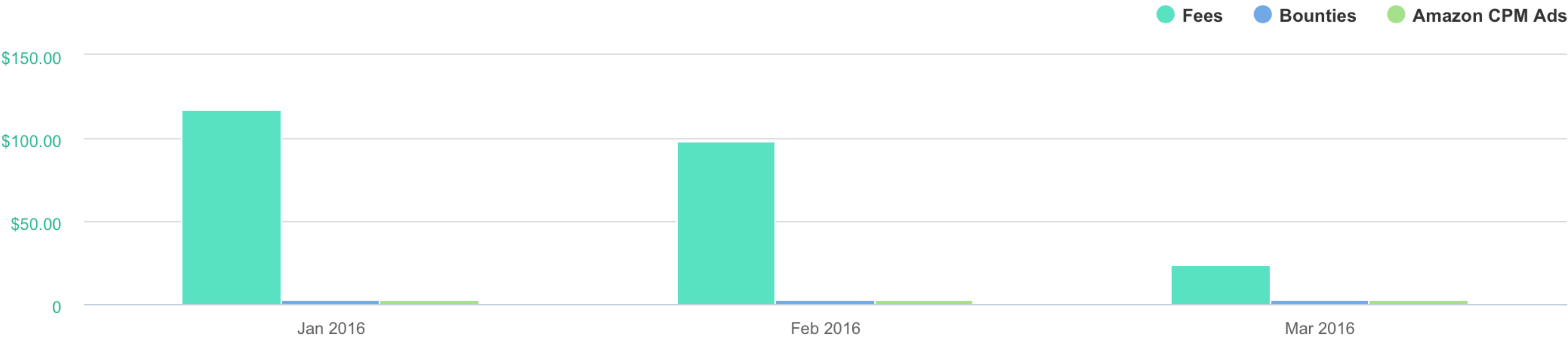
