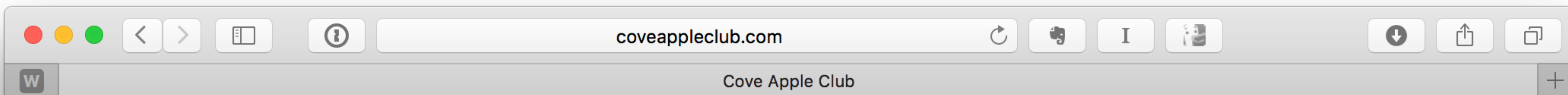

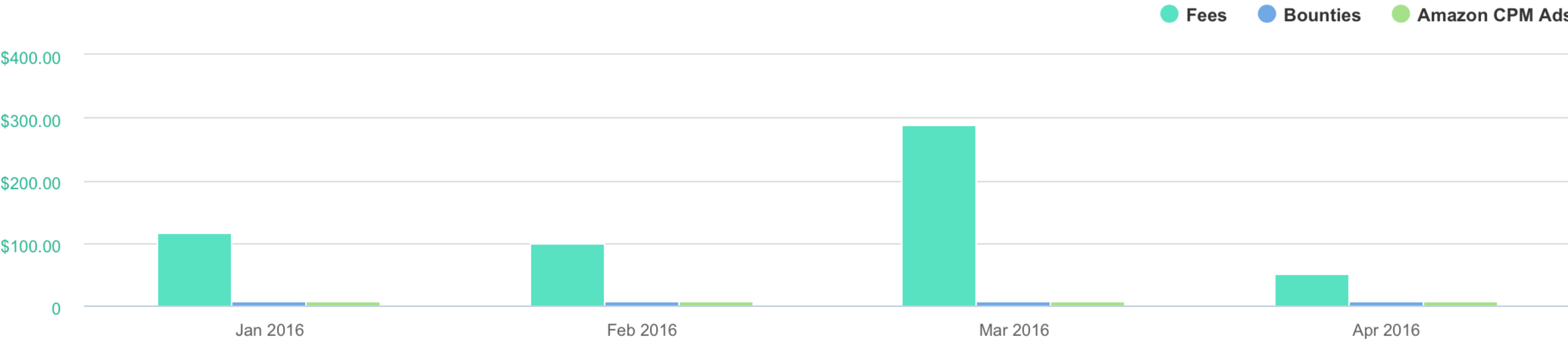

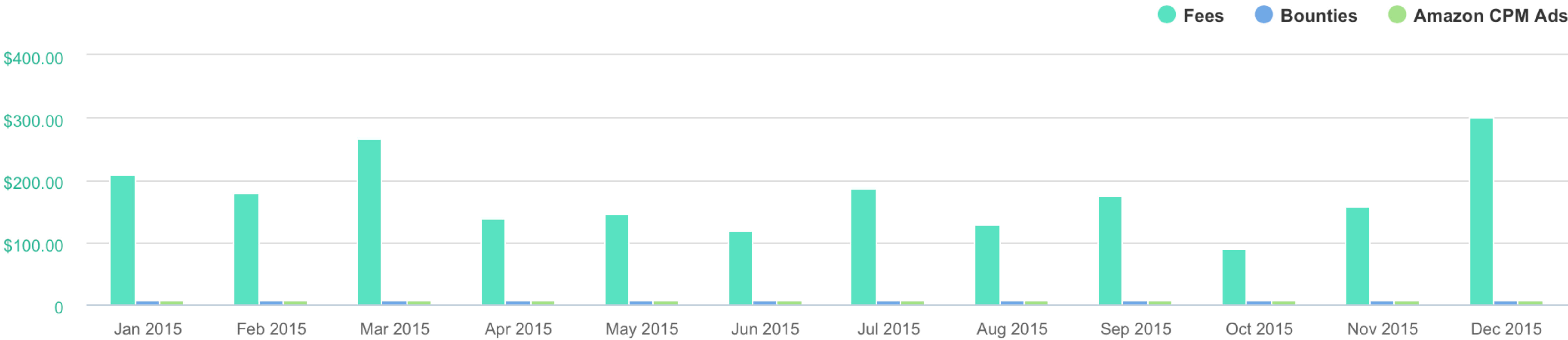

How Do They Do It?

WSJ: You also have a non-traditional content model. It's hard to break down Amazon Prime to see how that works when content is included along with two-day shipping.

Bezos: If you talk about the original genesis of prime seven years ago, it's a shipping program and you get free two-day shipping on a million items. Today, it's 15 million items. But Prime was designed to be about wanting faster delivery and not wanting to pay for it. ... So, if you change something to an all-you-can-eat buffet, then you don't feel guilty. That's the genesis.

WSJ: But that's expensive just offering that.

Bezos: **Yes, many things we do are expensive!** Refer back to before when I said “take a deep breath and be patient.” Deep yoga breaths, people! Yes, it's expensive. ***It's not like we didn't do some arithmetic ahead of time.*** Despite what some have said from time to time, Amazon is a for-profit business. So, ***we looked at some numbers, and we believed that this would be a good program for customers and for Amazon*** — that's the alignment I'm talking about. But it's also good for third-party sellers. Once we added fulfillment by Amazon, it's good for sellers, it's good for Amazon and it's good for the customer because they get an ***all-you-can-eat two-day shipping buffet.***

“We charge customers around \$700 to ship this safe, but when they buy it through Amazon they get it shipped for free,” says Pasquale Murena, marketing manager for Cannon Safe. “As a result, we get orders through Amazon every day.” In fact, Amazon will pick up the tab for shipping the safe even for non-Prime members, if they are willing to wait a few extra days for delivery. 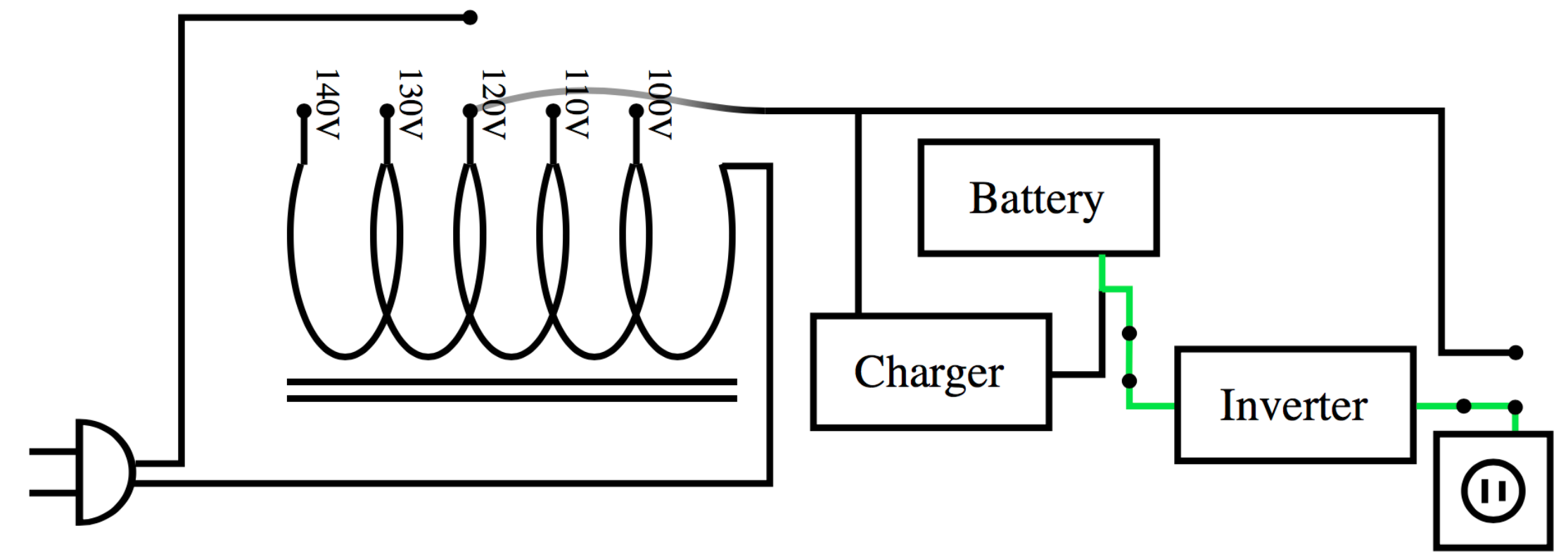

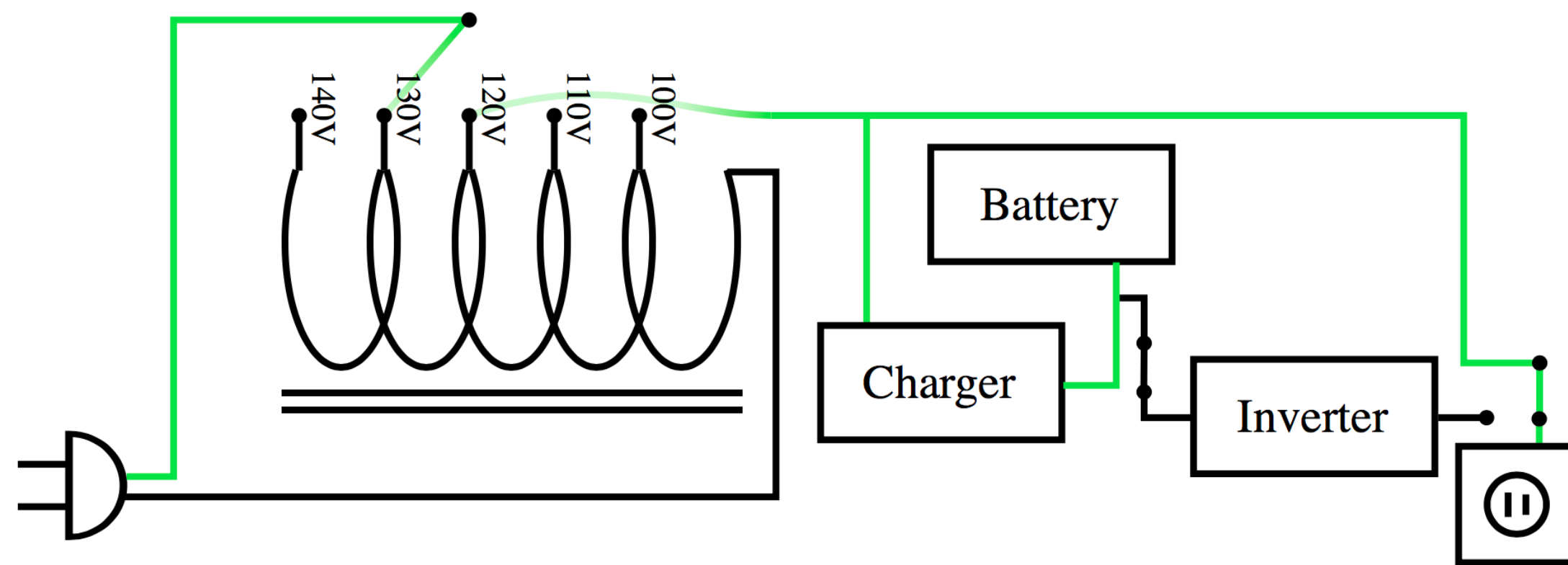

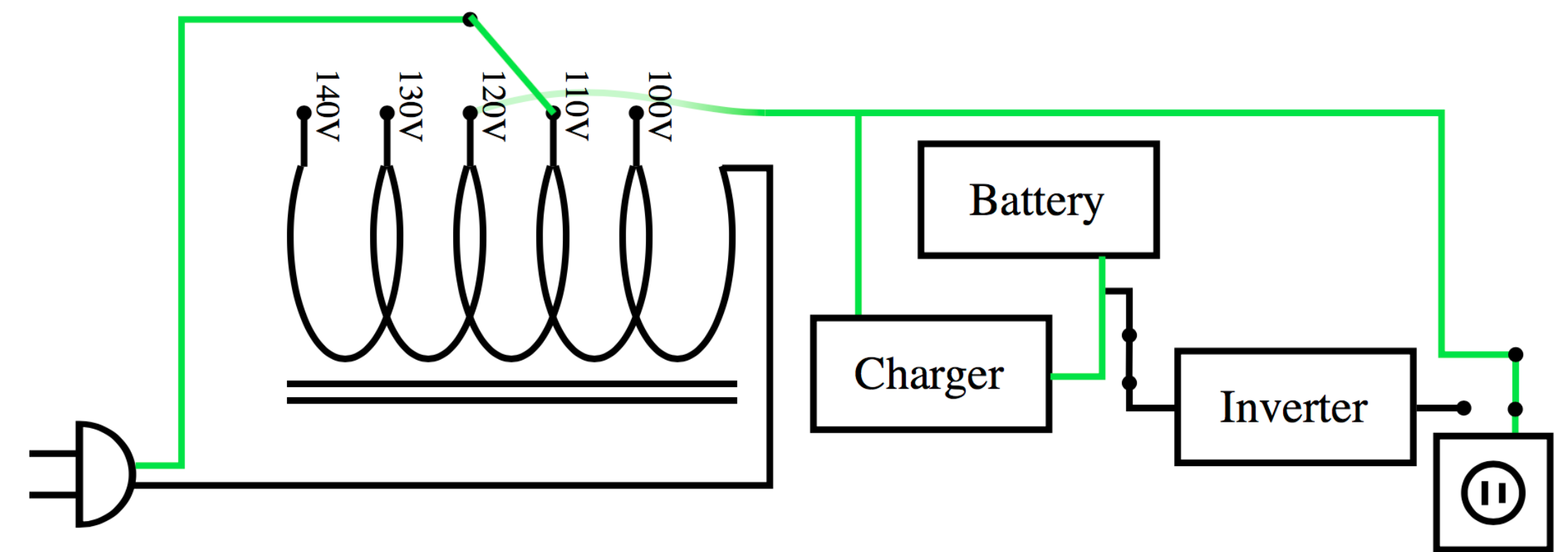

05.What size UPS should I choose?

First, you should determine the power requirements of your equipment as follows:

Insure that the equipment plugged into the battery power-supplied outlets does not exceed the UPS unit's rated capacity (1500VA/1000W for PR1500E, 2200VA/1600W for PR2200E). If rated unit capacities are exceeded, an overload condition may occur and cause the UPS unit to shut down or the circuit breaker to trip.

If the power requirements of your equipment are listed in units other than Volt-Amps (VA), convert Watts (W) or Amps (A) into VA by doing the calculations below. Note: The below equation only calculates the maximum amount of VA that the equipment can use, not what is typically used by the equipment at any one time. Users should expect usage requirements to be approximately 60% of below value.

Second, estimate the power requirements as follows:

- _____ Watts (W) x 2.0 = _____ VA or _____ Amps (A) x 230 = _____ VA
- Add the totals up for all pieces of equipment and multiply this total by 0.6 to calculate actual requirements. There are many factors that can affect the amount of power that your computer system will require. The total load that you will be placing on the battery-powered outlets should not exceed 80% of the unit's capacity.
