

AP THE ASSOCIATED PRESS STYLE BOOK 2016

- AP Stylebook, 2016 edition
- Used as the style and process reference by journalists, editors, business writing, educators
- Updated annually since 1953
- Over 600 changes since the 2016 edition
- "AP Style" reflects and shapes how we write and what we read in popular media



AP Style: Tech Terms

- "Web site" became "website" in the 2010 edition
- BUT, retain capital "W" and separate words for "the Web," "Web page" and "Web feed"

Website A location on the World Wide Web that maintains one or more pages at a specific address. Also, webcam, webcast and webmaster. But as a short form and in terms with separate words, the Web, Web page and Web feed. See **Web**.

AP Style: Tech Terms

- "E-mail" became "email" in the 2011 edition
- Retain the hyphen with "e-book," "e-commerce" and "e-business"

to citizens of the nation.

email Acceptable in all references for electronic mail. Many email or Internet addresses use symbols such as the at symbol (@), or the tilde (~) that cannot be transmitted correctly by some computers. When needed, spell them out and provide an explanatory editor's note. Use a hyphen with other e- terms: e-book, e-business, e-commerce.

embargo See boycott, embargo.
