## Emergency “Medic Alert” Information Built into iOS

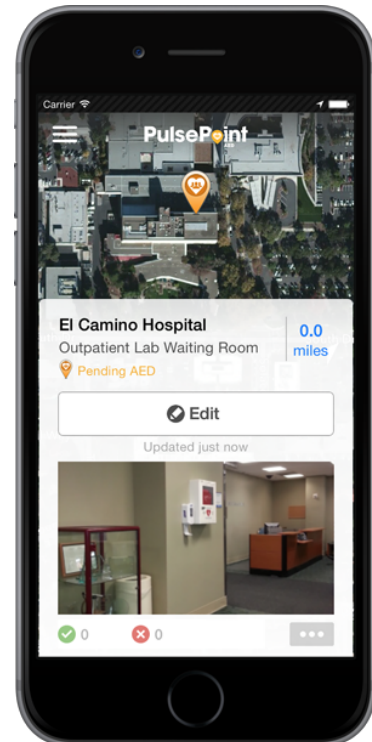
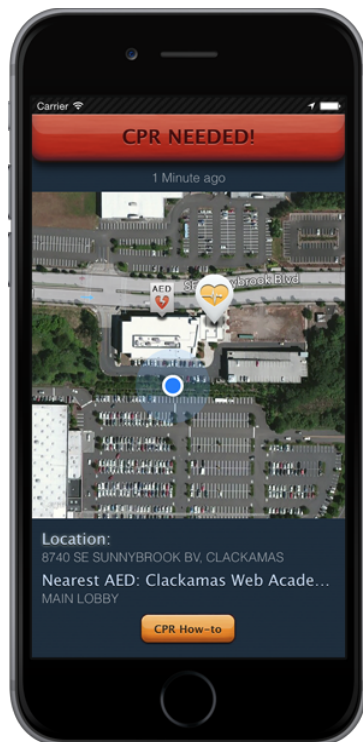
Slide to open phone and on the left lower area of the password panel is the word “Emergency”

If you click on this link, you will get a panel that allows 9-1-1 or other emergency numbers to be called without a password. Again, in the lower left area, you will also see “Medical ID”.

Click on this link to see what you have set-up in the Health App for your personal medical & contact info. This is primarily for emergency personnel to use for your benefit if you are found unconscious.

There may be little or no information in this panel, if you haven’t yet set it up. To initially set it up, open the Health App and it will take you through the process of add information. You can add whatever information you wish to share, including:

- Medical Conditions you have
- A Notes area where you can put your Physician’s Names & Contacts
- Any Allergies you have
- Medications you take
- Emergency Contacts—Names & Phone Numbers
- Your Blood Type
- Other Vital Statistics

Uses your iPhone’s accelerometer to gauge the depth & rhythm of CPR compressions.
