





Read Later Apps Always have something interesting to read



Read Later Apps

Solves a problem for us reading junkies

- If you're like me, you run across interesting things to read all the time...
- ...but you don't always have the time to read them right then
- You'd like to read them *sometime...*
- ...but then you forget about them when the next shiny object enters your gaze
- "Read Later" apps solve this problem!

Read Later Apps: what they do

Click-and-collect, but for the web

- You sign up for a Read Later app, and optionally, choose the paid tier
- Then you install the app's bookmarklets, browser extensions or other widgets to enable saving
- Later, browsing the web, you run across something you'd like to save
- You trigger the Read Later mechanism, and your article is saved
- You can then view a *readability-enhanced copy* of the article anytime, even when offline

Instapaper: The Original "Read Later" app

- 2007: Marco Arment, a web developer, wanted things to read on his subway commute to work, on the original iPhone
- He wrote a simple browser "bookmarklet" and back-end server script, and released it for free in 2008; later, turned it into a company & created a paid version
- IP changed hands a few times, is now a standalone company with a stable business model
- The original, and still the best, "Read Later" app, IMHO




Instapaper: the details

- Free & premium accounts
- Mac: browser widgets, Mac app, web app
- iOS: save from Share sheet, iOS app, web app
- \$30/year for Premium well worth it if you're a reading junkie!



Safari Reading List

Built-in and free!


- Built-in to Safari on Mac and iOS, free to use
- Available with a click in the Bookmarks menu, the Share sheet, or the browser address bar
- Syncs between devices automatically via iCloud
- Optionally, save full-text copies onboard your devices for offline reading



Pocket by Mozilla

Instapaper competitor from the people who bring you the Firefox browser

- Basic account is free: save, read later
- Premium is \$45/year 50% more than Instapaper
- Same widgets, apps & features as Instapaper
- No need to try this if Instapaper or Reading List can do what you need




Evernote

Remember everything, including what to read

- Not strictly a "Read Later" app, Evernote is a digital catch-all for saving, searching, finding *everything*
- Free tier lets you clip & save web pages, articles, bookmarks to the cloud, 60Mb/mo. limit
- Great apps for iOS, Mac, web app, etc.
- Much more than a "Read Later" app
- Premium is \$70/year, a bargain if you commit to it!


- The Club has expenses of about \$550/year







Apple's 35-year commitment to accessibility


Doing waaaaay more than is required


Zoom Text on Hover

Accessibility How-To Videos




How to use Hover Text




Magnify on Mac Where to find it

Scanning documents with the iOS Notes app



Scan documents in Notes app


Does a surprisingly good job!


- Added to Notes app about five years ago
