


Mac OS X 10.0 "Cheetah"

March 24, 2001




Mac OS X 10.0 "Cheetah" - March 24, 2001

- Sold as a boxed software on CD for \$129
- Huge throngs of Macheads at Apple's 3 retail stores: McLean, VA; Glendale, CA; Plano, TX
- iPod was still 8 months away
- Most popular Mac was the original "gumdrop" iMac G3
- First and still the only consumer desktop OS based on UNIX






What is Family Sharing?

Sharing is caring!

- Family Sharing lets as many as six family members share:
 - iTunes, App Store & Apple Books purchases
 - Family calendar
 - Family reminders
 - Family photos
- All without sharing an Apple ID account

Family Sharing is essentially the world's biggest half-price discount plan for couples!

And an even bigger discount for bigger families!

What is Family Sharing?

...and there's more!

- Family members can also share subscriptions to Apple services:
 - iCloud Storage (200Gb & 1Tb plans)
 - Apple Music
 - Apple TV+
 - Apple Fitness
 - Apple News+

Family Sharing basics

- One adult in the family is the Family Organizer, and invites as many as five people to join the Family Sharing group
- After accepting the invitation, all Family Sharing group members get immediate access to each other's music, movies, TV shows, books, eligible apps, subscriptions to Apple TV and Apple News+, and more

More Family Sharing basics

- Easily share photos in a shared Family Album
- Share a Family calendar
- Share Reminders
- Share their location with other Family members
- Even help locate a lost device with Find My


Best of all: Family Sharing

- Family Sharing is free
- Family Sharing is super-easy to set up
- Once enabled, Family Sharing is set up automatically on all devices

Requirements


- All family members must have an Apple ID, and be signed into their devices
- Requires macOS 10.10 or later, iOS 8 or later, iPad OS, or iCloud for Windows 7 or later

Family Sharing Setup Walk-Through




On iOS / iPadOS:


- The Club has expenses of about \$550/year

ZELLE: Zelle is a secure, instant bank-to-bank transfer that is supported by **almost all US-based banks** and credit unions. There is no fee to sender or recipient, and no account information is ever sent to the recipient.

- On your iPhone:
 - Open the mobile app for your bank or credit union, then look for "Transfer / Zelle" in the app. Choose "Send or Receive money with Zelle," then follow the prompts to send money to banking@coveappleclub.com.
- On your Mac:
 - Visit your bank website, then click the link for "Transfer / Zelle." Follow the prompts to send money to banking@coveappleclub.com.

PAYPAL: PayPal is the internet's original instant money transfer service. PayPal is secure, safe and used by millions to pay for goods and services every day. There is no fee to send money to the Cove Apple Club when funded by a bank account linked to your PayPal account.

- On your iPhone with the PayPal app installed:
 - o Open the PayPal app on your iPhone and login, then tap "Send." In the "Name, @username, email, ..." field, enter @coveappleclub, then follow the prompts to send your donation.
- On your Mac:
 - Click this link to go to the Cove Apple Club page on PayPal.com. Enter a donation amount and click Next, then login to your account and send your donation, or:







Do Not Disturb While Driving

- You can set up your iPhone to automatically reply to texts or calls when you're driving
- When enabled, your phone stays silent and dark; if someone texts you, they instantly receive a reply letting them know you're driving

Do Not Disturb While Driving


- They can text back "urgent" to send the message through
- Also works for phone calls
- Works with or without
 CarPlay or Bluetooth



Many additional settings

- Can activate automatically, manually, with or without CarPlay
- Can auto-reply to no one,
 Recent, Favorites, or All Contacts
- Can also customize reply message









How to use Do Not Disturb While Driving


With iOS 11 and later, your iPhone can sense when you might be driving and prevent notifications.

With iOS 11 and later, the first time your iPhone senses that you might be driving, it shows a description of the Do Not Disturb While Driving feature after you stop. If it doesn't appear, follow the steps below.

Tap Turn On While Driving, and it will turn on automatically when your iPhone connects to your car via Bluetooth₁ or when your iPhone senses driving motion. You can change the method that your iPhone
