What the heck is going on?

Why is Facebook suddenly flooded with hundreds of millions of gibberish posts like these, that get *immense* engagement (likes and shares)?

In many cases they're coming from pages purporting to be "blogs," which in fact are nodes in an "affiliate network."



These networks are like Tupperware, LuLaRoe, Herbalife or Amway: they sell clicks, and collect Facebook "likes" and comments in order to sell that engagement to ad networks. Where is the money — the incentive — coming from for these "affiliate networks"?

How this works is murky, but it's clear that someone has found a way to gain absolutely stellar reach for these apparent spam posts.

What they have in common is help from these sketchy "affiliate networks."

Now on to even more troubling posts following the same pattern...



Look at the comments (often hundreds of thousands!) and you'll see people simply posting that data, *plus specific details*.

Thanks to advances in sentiment analysis and the declining cost of compute power, it's possible to get remarkable insights from masses of text-based data.

Without more research, or perhaps even a subpoena, it's impossible to nail down exactly what's happening here, but there are some clear precedents.

If these "affiliate networks" aren't being used to improve some voter profiling project, it would be a surprise.

Naturally, Facebook is either oblivious to these actors (hard to believe), or is complicit in the scheme because it brings in a lot of cash. What can you do?

#1 — Don't interact with pages / posts from anyone YOU DON'T KNOW PERSONALLY.
