

No matter what happens, always remember:


Apple is forever doomed

It was a good year to be invested in the US stock market.

The Dow Jones 30 rose 13.7%.

The S&P 500 rose 24.2%.

The NASDAQ rose 43.4%.

Because of a 26.8% decline in 2022, AAPL is up 8% since 2021








But aside from that, Apple had a tough 2023 Fiscal year ended September 30, 2023

- Revenue declined 2.8%, to \$383,285,000,000
- Gross margin declined 0.9%, to \$169,148,000,000
 - >80% of the decline can be attributed to adverse foreign exchange, thanks to the incredible strength of the US dollar in the past two years
- Earnings per share grew 3% to \$6.13/share
- Apple returned \$91,000,000,000 to shareholders in dividends in FY23
- Apple spent \$27,000,000,000 in R&D in FY22, investing in their future products, production & supply chains. That's \$73,000,000/day on R&D.








The Mac turns 40 this year.

The Macintosh came out a year before Microsoft Windows 1.0, Atari ST, New Coke, and Sour Patch Kids.

Mac sales last year were \$29.3-billion.




Keep in mind that when Steve returned to Apple in 1997, Apple's annual gross revenues were under \$4-billion, they were losing money on everything, had zero cash in the bank, and might not make payroll the next month.




Apple did not even begin reporting Services as a category of sales until 2018.


Last year it brought in \$85.2-billion — almost 3x as much as the Mac.

If Apple's Services business was a standalone company, it would be bigger than Boeing, Caterpillar, IBM, Amex, HP, American Airlines, Intel, Nike and Coca-Cola.



Services is now Apple's 2nd-biggest business, led only by the mammoth iPhone business.






The "Wearables" category did not exist in 2017.

It includes Watch, AirPods, and Beats.

Later this year, Vision Pro will join the Wearables category.

Look for a big jump.



Apple Watch brings in more revenue than the entire Swiss watch industry, which has been around for 275 years.

\$4 out of every \$5 spent on smart watches worldwide goes to Apple.

AirPods were laughed at when they were introduced in September, 2016.

Now it's estimated that Apple sells \$15-billion of AirPods every year, and has >80% market share of the category.

Every other wireless earphone maker is fighting over the few crumbs left after Apple sells all the AirPods they can make.


